

# Pacific tuna tagging reaches milestone

Next month, the 400,000th tuna will be tagged as part of current work by the Secretariat of the Pacific Community's oceanic fisheries program to better understand the ecology of skipjack, yellowfin and bigeye tuna.

The SPC's principal fisheries scientist, Dr Simon Nicol, says it's a milestone in efforts to improve the sustainability of Pacific fisheries.
